The UK Kidney Association (UKKA) is working with Patients Know Best (PKB) and NHS Lothian to support you in managing your kidney care by providing:

- Access to your test results
- A personal journal to help keep a record of any conditions or symptoms
- Resource library access to information and support services
- Symptom tracker a log of symptoms to share with teams (where applicable)
- Record sharing with carers or extended health or care teams
- Connecting wearable devices to share data with teams in real-time
- The ability to store important information -• diagnoses, medications, allergies or clinical correspondence, all in one place.

How to sign up and register

Please let a member of the clinical team know you wish to sign up to view your health data in Patients Know Best.

The team will then create your record and you will receive an email, which will contain a registration link. Clicking on this link will complete the process and you will be able to log in and see your data.
